

LIBERATION SCOTLAND COMMITTEE RESPONSE TO YES UNITED PROPOSED FOREIGN POLICY FOR AN INDEPENDENT SCOTLAND.

We fundamentally disagree with these proposals to align the ‘foreign policy’ position of an independent Scotland ahead of achieving independence, on the basis of continuing to follow the UK’s historic position of supporting the US ‘special relationship’, membership of NATO and as the unwilling host of US/UK nuclear weapons on the Clyde.

This “Yes United” policy position will greatly damage Scotland’s case for self-determination (currently being taken by Liberation Scotland at the U.N.) and will not deliver security or sovereignty for a future Scottish state.
